# ABOUT THE SCHOOL

The eco-friendly campus and the surrounding provides an ideal atmosphere for education.

Christ Central School Thiruvalla is a co-educational English Medium School affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi (Aff. No. 930459). Christ Central School is owned and managed by the Catholic missionary fathers of the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate - the CMI congregation.

St. Kuriakose Elias Chavara, born on 10<sup>th</sup> February 1805 in Kainakary, Kerala was instrumental in founding the CMI Congregation for the spiritual renewal and all round development of the society.

Christ Central School is a part of the CMI St Joseph's Province, Thiruvananthapuram and is under the management of Kuriakose Elias Educational Trust (KEET). Its immediate management is by Mar Baselios CMI Ashram Muthoor, Thiruvalla. The institution has all the rights and privileges granted by the constitution of India as a minority educational institution.

## ART/SKILL EDUCATION

Imbibing the spirit of the NEP, the school presents the students with the opportunity to develop their talents by providing training in Music, Classical Dance, Western Dance, Drawing, Painting, Key Board, Abacus, Band, Guitar, Violin, Kung Fu and Roller Skating. Intensive training sessions are arranged to prepare students to participate in various literary and cultural competitions held at different levels.

## ROBOTICS & ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

With a vision to future, we have set up separate Robotics Labs to provide systematic hands-on training to our kids. Artificial Intelligence is being taught as a skill subject to get our students ready to grab emerging opportunities.

## VALUE EDUCATION & LIFE SKILLS

Forming persons who are fully human and fully alive is the aim of our educational endeavours. Character formation and academic excellence are granted equal status in our institution. Hence training in values and life skills are given prime importance. Value Education classes, Annual Retreat, Orientation Programmes, Health and Physical Education, Career Guidance and various Club activities arranged at the school combine to attain this goal.





## SPORTS AND GAMES

In an era where physical training is taking a back seat, coaching is given to students in basketball, football, throw ball, badminton and athletics by formally trained coaches. ## GUIDANCE & COUNSELLING CELL

The school has a full time qualified counsellor to provide guidance and counselling to students with various difficulties.

In order to provide the best service the routine office transactions such as issue of certificates, daily accounts and financial dealings connected with the school are done through the school office which functions from 8.30 am to 4.30 pm on regular week days.

# admission procedure



1. Pupils seeking admission to L.K.G, U.K.G & Std I should register their names before the end of January.
2. There will be no written test for the students seeking admission to the K.G. Section.

### Age Limits on Admission

Pre - KG	-	Age 3 as on 31st May
LKG	-	Age 4 as on 31st May
UKG	-	Age 5 as on 31st May
1st Std	-	Age 6 as on 31st May



3. The admission to the other classes will be based on the availability of seats and the applicants' performance in the entrance test.
4. The students will be tested in their basic knowledge of English, Hindi, Malayalam, Mathematics and Science based on the topics they have learnt in the previous year.
5. The entrance exam is for a duration of two hours and the results of the same will be announced on the next working day. The results will be published on the school notice board and can also be enquired over the phone.
6. Short listed candidates will have to appear for an interview with the Principal on the specified day.
7. The candidate must be accompanied by his/her parent at the time of interview. Attested copy of the birth certificate and Aadhaar Card of the candidate must be submitted to the office along with their application form in advance.
8. The students must submit their T.C to the school office at least by the 2nd week of June.

1. The students seeking admission to Std. XI in the Science Stream (I & II) will be tested in the knowledge of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. For the Psychology Stream (III) the test will be held in Physics, Chemistry & Biology.
2. The students seeking admission to Std. XI in the Commerce stream will be tested in the knowledge of English, Statistics and Economics and Mathematics (optional).
3. Candidates seeking admission to Std. XI must enter the stream as PCMC (Computer + Maths) PCMB (Biology + Maths), PCPB (Psychology + Biology) or Commerce (Maths/IP).
4. Students who have appeared for Mathematics Basic in their Class X Board Examinations are not eligible to apply for any Stream involving Mathematics (They may opt for Commerce with IP or Biology with Psychology).
5. While returning the filled - in application form, a passport size photograph of the applicant and the mark list of the 1<sup>st</sup> terminal examination (Std.X) must be submitted to the school office.
6. The candidates should submit the following documents at the time of the admission.
  - a) Attested copy of the Birth Certificate
  - b) Copy of the Aadhaar Card
  - c) Original Mark list of the Board examination.
  - d) Transfer Certificate from the institution last attended.
  - e) Course and Conduct Certificate from the institution last attended.
7. School Fee must be remitted as one time payment or as nine installments in the bank. There will be 5% discount in the amount of the fees, if paid in a single installment at the beginning of the academic year.
