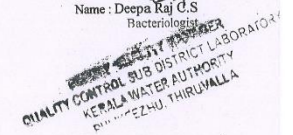

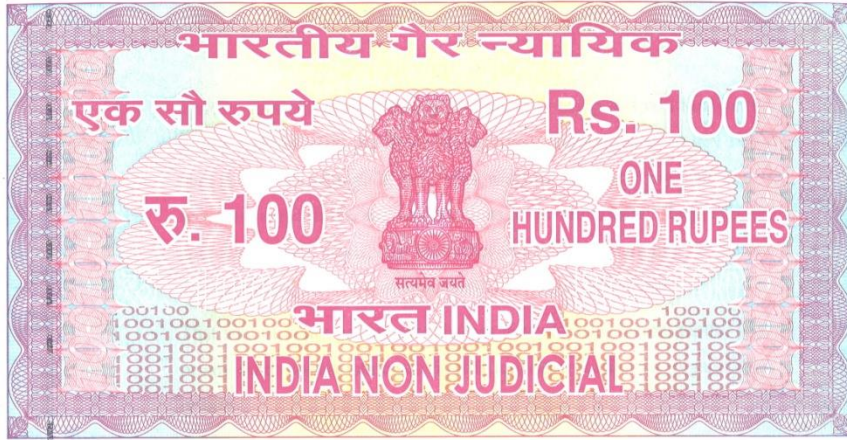

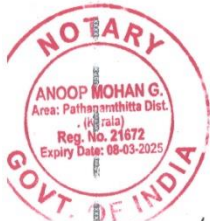

### **Staff and Student Strength**

### **Staff Enrichment Programmes**

A true teacher is a lifelong learner, constantly growing to inspire others. To enhance professional excellence, several training and orientation programmes were organised during the year.

A training on the Holistic Progress Card was held on 21st May 2025, led by Mr. Renjith R, Principal of Sree Saraswathy Vidya Mandir, Karikod.

## **A look at the results of the Board Examinations held in 2024–25:**

In the CBSE Class XII examination, 5 students secured A1 in all subjects, 31 students scored above 90%, 87 students passed with distinction, and 28 students achieved first class.

Aksa Merin Cherian of the Commerce stream brought immense pride to our school by scoring an outstanding 499 out of 500 in the Class 12 Board Examination and she secured second rank at the All India level.

Diya Elsa Binu was the school topper from the Science stream.

In the CBSE Class X (SSE 2025) examination, 17 students secured A1 in all subjects, 35 students scored above 90%, 17 students passed with distinction, and 28 students achieved first class.

Angel Maria Sinu and Ann Maria Sinu were the school toppers.
